

**You landed in Cancun and you're ready to (back)roll into the Caribbean waters? :)
Before the sun hits your white skin and you will enjoy a tasty margarita with Cozumel swallows and hummingbirds flying above your hammock, you will have to reach our island.**

Here is the most popular and budget-friendly way to do it: by ADO Bus or a shared taxi and a ferry.

At the airport:


The two terminals for international flights at the Cancun airport are terminals 2 and 3. If you flew with an American carrier, most likely you arrived at Terminal 3. If you're flying from Europe or with WestJet/Air Canada/Condor and a few more airlines, you may land on Terminal 2. Terminal 1 serves predominantly as a domestic terminal. You can look up which terminal is assigned to the airlines you're flying with [here](#).

In each terminal, after passing through the customs, you'll find a red ADO bus stand where they sell tickets (payments in MXN/USD or via credit card). You will most probably get many offers of a taxi/shuttle bus ride - if you want to spend more money, go for it, it will take less time. But if you prefer to save \$ for something better (like diving in cenotes for example), go for ADO. The price of the ticket to Playa del Carmen is around 210 pesos, 9-10 in USD (2020). You can also take a bus to Cancun city and spend a night or two there. ADO buses come with AC, reclined seats, power plugs and, allegedly, WiFi. The ride to Playa takes around an hour and 15 minutes. From ADO bus station in Playa you have to walk around 5 minutes to a passenger terminal where you board a ferry heading to Cozumel. Note that there are 2 carriers: [UltraMar](#) - blue and yellow logo, quite luxurious ferries with a bar and live music, round trip costs around 400 pesos/USD 20); and [WinJet](#): orange boats, around 360 pesos/18 USD, just a little bit less elegant but cheaper. The last ferry from Playa del Carmen to Cozumel leaves at 11 pm. You can buy the tickets right before boarding.

If you're staying with us for your Divemaster Internship or Instructor Development Course, someone will come by car to pick you up from the ferry terminal in Cozumel. Therefore, it's important that you contact Ken (+521 987 111 8780) or Meg (+521 987 141 7186) on Whatsapp or FB messenger in advance to let them know which ferry you're arriving with. There is a Starbucks Cafe at the ferry terminal in Playa where WiFi is easily accessible. In case for some reason there is no one available to pick you up, don't worry - just take a taxi (to the left heading out from the terminal in Cozumel) and ask the driver to take you to *Calle 2, numero 680, entre Avenida 30 y 35*. It's a white 3-storey house with a blue CDS sign over the gate. The ride shouldn't take more than 10 minutes and should cost you roughly 50 pesos, you will have that reimbursed (if coming for a DM or IDC course only). If you feel like walking, it shouldn't take more than 10-15 minutes. Leaving the ferry terminal, head left to Calle 2 and follow it for the next 6 blocks until you reach a busy 2-lane Avenida 30, cross it and you should already see our house.
