

COVID – 19 Policies and Dive Procedures

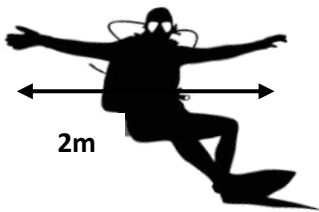

Based on the recommendations from the CDC, WHO, Divers Alert Network and local authorities, this is a summary of how we will help protect all of our divers and instructors.

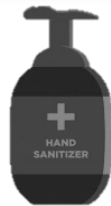
Maintaining a Safe Distance

As divers, we prefer the buddy system! Yet, now we will continue to think of our buddies above water too! We will maintain a safe distance of 2 meters above water, at our facilities, and on the boat as much as possible.



Barrier Protection is Mandatory – For Us, For You, and For Cozumel

PPE Face Masks or Coverings are mandatory for everyone in Cozumel at all times except when in the water. You must bring your own face mask or covering with you.



Keeping it Clean

Cozumel Dive School promises to make you feel comfortable and clean at all times. We will be cleaning and sanitizing throughout the day including the equipment facilities, bathrooms, classrooms, videorooms, transportation and ensuring hand sanitizer is readily available, at any given moment!



Disinfecting Gear – Purchasing Personal Mouthpieces

We have always prided ourself in our high quality gear maintenance. Now we will bring it to the next level.

Personal Regulator Mouthpieces will be available for purchase.

BCDs and Wetsuits- will all be soaked and washed separately in Anti Viral and Anti Bacterial solution

Masks, Snorkels, and Regulators- will all be soaked and washed separately in Steramine™

(an EPA Registered, multi purpose anti microbial sanitizer)
